Action Research for Community Adaptation in Bangladesh (ARCAB) is a long term action Research Programme on Community Based Adaptation (CBA) to



climate change in 5 major ecosystems in Bangladesh. The programme is jointly managed by Bangladesh centre for Advanced Studies (BCAS) and

International Institute for Environment and Development (IIED).

ARCAB is going to organize 1st national CBA conference in April 2012 in order to exhibit the theories and practices of CBA in Bangladesh. The two days event will provide knowledge sharing spaces among academicians, practitioners, researchers and CBA communities. The objectives are:
